Frandsen Corporation owns and operates three manufacturing businesses across Minnesota. Plastech Corporation is a custom injection molder providing 24/7 services to large OEM clients. Industrial Netting is a custom converter of plastic netting. Miller Manufacturing produces farm, ranch, and pet products. All three businesses manufacture, sell, and distribute products on a global scale today.

“The acquisition will allow JD Products to expand offerings to clientele while maintaining an economic price point,” said Plastech general manager Jerry Miller. “Frandsen Corporation brings over 60 years of injection-molding expertise and resources to current JD Products customers.” The deal raises the press fleet of the companies to 69 molding machines ranging from 55-ton to 1500-ton.
